

**HOLZER HOLZER & FISTEL, LLC ANNOUNCES THAT IT HAS FILED A CLASS ACTION LAWSUIT ON BEHALF OF INVESTORS IN CAMELOT INFORMATION SYSTEMS, INC.**

ATLANTA, GA - - (Marketwire –January 6, 2011) – – Holzer Holzer & Fistel, LLC announces that it has filed a class action lawsuit in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York on behalf of purchasers of Camelot Information Systems, Inc. (“Camelot” or the “Company”) (NYSE: CIS) common stock who purchased shares between July 21, 2010 and August 17, 2011, inclusive (the “Class Period”). The lawsuit alleges, among other things, that Camelot knew but failed to disclose that attrition of its employees was having a negative impact on the Company’s ability to attract new customers. Further, the lawsuit alleges Camelot’s contract with its most important customer, IBM, would not be renewed on the same terms.

If you purchased Camelot common stock during the Class Period, you have the legal right to petition the Court to be appointed a "lead plaintiff." A lead plaintiff is a representative party that acts on behalf of other class members in directing the litigation. Any such request must satisfy certain criteria and be made no later than March 5, 2012. Any member of the purported class may move the Court to serve as lead plaintiff through counsel of their choice, or may choose to do nothing and remain an absent class member.
